Provision of documents – Western Harbour Tunnel and Beaches Link Business Cases

I refer to the resolution of the Legislative Council concerning the above documents of 6 August 2020.

I note that the documents referred to in the resolution are Cabinet documents, and that the Legislative Council has no power to require such documents to be produced.

On this occasion, however, the Government has decided to provide the document sought to the Legislative Council on a voluntary basis, even though the Council has no power to require such production. Please find the document enclosed.

Please note I am advised that the document contains sensitive commercial information, the public disclosure of which has the potential to detrimentally affect the State's capacity to secure the best possible commercial terms for the people of NSW in the procurement of the relevant program. The document is therefore produced on a confidential basis, on the understanding that it will be made available to members of the Legislative Council only and not publically disclosed.
